Here we are heading into March of 2006, time waits for no man. **Today is the day to serve The LORD!** We must not put off til tomorrow what we can do today. There is an attitude that prevails in the Body of Christ that suggests that tomorrow I can start obeying The LORD. When I say tomorrow, I'm speaking of anything other than the present. Procrastination can be an evil thing. If we look up the word "procrastinate" in Webster's 1828 American Dictionary we find it defined as: To put off from day to day; to delay; to defer to a future time; as, to procrastinate repentance. Any attitude that suggests I can wait until tomorrow to obey God is an evil attitude. Jesus made this very clear! He said in Matthew 24:42, "Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your LORD doth come." One thing is for sure and Jesus said it, we will not know the exact time of His return. This reminds me of my childhood. I was raised in a single parent home; my mother raised four kids by herself. When we kids were at home during the day, while mother worked, we were expected to have the apartment picked up, neat, with the dishes done. We, of course, knew exactly when mom would get home. She got of work at 4 p.m. and was home by 4:20. Being kids we would naturally wait until the last possible moment before we started obeying our mother to have the house clean before she arrived at home. Numerous times the vacuum cleaner was just put away and the last dish was placed in the drain tray just as mom entered the door. It was a mad dash to get the house clean and I'm sure many of you have been through the same thing. So what would have happened if mom got off early and entered the door at noon? She would have found the house the same as she had left it and that would have occurred because we had no idea that she was going to arrive when she did. We are told in the scriptures that Jesus is coming back (John 14:3), but it is very clear we cannot know the exact time of His arrival. Can you imagine what kind of world this would be if we did know? For the most part there would be little Christian servitude, and repentance wouldn't be because one wanted to but because one had to. Our God knows what He is doing. Jesus said in Matt. 24:44, "Therefore be ye ready; for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh." Verse 46 says, "Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing." **Doing what???**

Watching, waiting, and expecting His return at any moment. If as children, our mother would have said I don't know when I'll be home but I want this house clean when I get here, then as soon as breakfast was over we would have been at work cleaning that house. It wouldn't have mattered to mom if it were done so long as we were working at it when we had the opportunity to do it. We have that opportunity today and Jesus said it is evil to waste that opportunity. He said in verses 48&49, "But and if that evil servant shall say in his heart, My lord delayeth his coming; And shall begin to smite his fellowservants, and to eat and drink with the drunken;" In other words, if we as Christians adopt the attitude that Jesus isn't coming anytime soon, and begin to do whatever; we are evil in His sight, and we actually put ourselves in harms way. Verses 50&51 say, "The lord of that servant shall come in a day when he looketh not for him, and in an hour that he is not aware of, And shall cut him asunder, and appoint him his portion with the hypocrites: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth." Let's heed the words of our Lord while there is still time. If you know you're supposed to be doing something now then don't put it off til tomorrow.
